

From the Principal's desk....

VPM's TMC Law College has been the only law college in the whole of Thane district from 1972 till 2002. The college caters to the aspirants of legal education by offering LL B (3 years) professional law degree programme under the University of Mumbai. The college will soon become the only NAAC Accredited law college in the second cycle under the University. We are gearing up with all the preparations.

The college proudly shares that our alumnus Ladyship Mrs Sharmila Deshmuk of 1992 batch assumed charge as Honble Additional Judge of Bombay High Court in July 2022!!

The college aims at providing quality legal education, training in the skills essential for legal practitioners and inculcating discipline, values and a sense of social responsibility. All endeavours are made to maximize the opportunities for both the facilitators of learning and the learners. Two

significant workshops, one on Energy Conversation and the other on Mediation were organized. Special lecture was conducted on Accountancy for Lawyers. We introduced an Add on Certificate Programme on Disaster Management Law for the Semester IV students from this year. We strengthened the legal literacy activities of the Legal Aid Cell by integrating the activities with the Practical Training projects of second year students. The students have zealously participated in these activities visiting schools, colleges etc.

We are grateful to His Lordship Shri Abhay Oka, Honble Judge Supreme Court of India and Lordship's mother Smt Vasanti Shreenivas Oka for generous donation and constitution of a special award. From the year 2022-2023 there will be a new award: Adv Shri Shreenivas Waman Oka Cash Prize for the topper in the final year. For 2022-23 this prize is won by Ms Priyanka Acharya, the topper of the college in May 2023 examination. We heartily congratulate her!!

University of Mumbai has implemented revised the LL B syllabus for the first year students from 2022-23; this revised syllabus will be progressively applied to this batch and future batches. The CBCS has also changed from 60: 40 to 75 : 25. The new curriculum has brought fresh air; the evaluation is now based on 25% internal (college) and 75% external (university).

The nation is at the threshold of implementation of National Education Policy 2020. NEP 2020 envisages a single overarching National Higher Education Regulatory Council. But legal education is excluded from this body. According to NEP 2020 single stream colleges will be phased out. We may become part of our composite VPM arts, commerce, science colleges'

cluster or transform into multidisciplinary institution. With Bar Council of India recognized BA LL B, B Sc LL B, B Com LL B, BBA LL B, B Tech LL B there is huge scope for actualizing interdisciplinary studies. All this will depend on the decisions of Bar Council of India, University and the government. NEP declares the importance of regional languages in education, particularly legal education. Legal education under the University honours Marathi by providing question paper in Marathi and permitting rendering of answers in Marathi. The institute continuously ensures special lectures in Marathi.

With sincere gratitude to all stakeholders we humbly present the annual college magazine Vidhijna 2022-23. We wish the students all the best and wait to hear their wellness and achievements in their career

Since law college inception we are engaged in Legal Awareness Activities. Justice Shri Krishna Iyer had been to our college in late 1980 to promote Legal awareness.

The College has established 'Legal Aid Clinic' (Known as Legal Aid Cell) which shall open for all the poor and needy people on every Friday and Saturday. The Legal Aid Cell office is located on first floor of the Law College Building.

In 2022-2023, the Legal Aid Cell has conducted the following programs;

Para Legal Volunteers

37 students from First, Second and Third year LLB were admitted as PLV by the Thane District Legal Services Authority, Thane.

These students shall work for DLSA and also for the Legal Aid Cell of the College. These students do participate in different legal awareness activities as instructed by the DLSA and College Legal Aid Cell.

Azadi ka Amrut Mahostav was celebrated with full joy and happiness by our college. Many programs related to legal awareness and patriotism were organised. 
Thane Jail Visit

Essay and Drawing Competition






❖ SPECIAL LECTURE AND WORKSHOPS ❖

Dr. V. N. Bedekar Memorial Lecture – “Prison Law and Reform”

Vidya Prasarak Mandal's T.M.C. Law College, Thane organized a program to felicitate two President Medal winning police officers from Thane city. The event was organized at Panini Auditorium in the campus on 8th August 2022 at 6 pm. Thane Central Jail Superintendent Shri. Harshad Ahirrao was recently awarded the President Medal for 'Prison Reform Work' while Senior Police Inspector of Naupada Police Station Shri. Sanjay Dhumal was awarded the President Medal for his outstanding service. In this felicitation ceremony Dr. Mr. Harshad Ahirrao delivered Dr.V.N. Bedekar memorial Lecture on "Prison Law and Reforms". The program was presided over by Dr. Vijay Bedekar, President of Vidya Prasarak Mandal'.

While replying to the felicitation, Mr. Dhumal humbly attributed his success to the police officers who worked with him. When a building caught fire in Naupada, Mr. Dhumal had saved the lives of 19 people: he brought that event alive. He said the police needed to have both social awareness and knowledge of the law. Mr. Ahirrao in his memorial lecture explained the psychology behind the incarceration and said that reforms are needed to improve the way criminals go home from prison. He himself mentioned the reforms he had made in the prison. He has improved many things like education, food, health, free legal services, training, prayer, discipline. When many prisoners return home, these reforms help them become better citizens. He said that the intended function of the law in punishing is to reform the criminal.



Disaster reduction... increases the self-reliance of people at risk—in other words, it empowers them."

In the same spirit, special hands-on training in Disaster Management was conducted at Vidhya Prasarak Mandal's Law College, Thane as part of the Add on Certificate Program in Disaster Management Law. We were fortunate to have two exceptional Master Trainers from Yashwantrao Chavan Academy of Development Administration (YASHDA) Pune, namely, Shri. Vivek Naidu and Shri. Lakhan Gaikwad.

The session started at 5.00 pm. in the Manu Hall (Moot Court Hall) of the College. Assistant Professor Mrs. Krishna Kamat started the program by welcoming everyone and introducing the master trainers, after which the In-charge Principal Dr. Srividhya Jayakumar felicitated the master hamees and welcomed all. Mr. Vivek Naidu started the program by engaging the students in brain teaser activities to get full concentration of the students in their training. Mr. Naidu explained how important disaster management training is in our day-to-day life as a disaster, whether natural or man-made, can strike at any time and at any place and we must be equipped with all the basic training to survive. One should be able to save oneself and others with the help of limited available resources. As the training progressed, more and more interesting elements were included in the training.

"Some of the important measures mentioned by Mr. Naidu are as follows" :

- 1) If the finger is cut, apply pure turmeric or immediately press the finger for 3 minutes.


- 2) Toothache/fit/dizziness - Keep such patients in such a state that the blood supply to the head will be increased until they recover. Do not give water to drink until you are sure that you are clean.
- 3) Never induce vomiting if vomiting occurs.
- 4) In case of cardiac arrest, give CPR to such person at 120 per minute until recovery.
- 5) Contact a doctor immediately if bitten by a dog or any other animal.
- 6) Burn the stick with which the snake was killed and washes off the blood of the snake so that other snakes do not smell it.
- 7) Never approach a burning person in front while rescuing/extinguishing it. Go behind and throw a blanket over him/ and also admit him to the hospital.
- 8) Run away and control breathing if attacked by bees.
- 9) Never give water to a road accident victim/ if necessary wet a handkerchief and apply it to his lips.
- 10) If everyone is going out of the house, remove the regulator of the gas cylinder and put a safety cap on the cylinder / keep the regulator closed when not in use / in case of accidental gas leakage, open the doors and windows so that the gas escapes through the air and avoids danger. Electric buttons should not be switched on or off by mistake as there is a risk of fire when switching the button on and off.

At the end of the training, our students were taken to the basketball court of the college, where they were trained to put out fires with utmost caution and safety. Because it is often found that despite having fire fighting extinguishers available in our area, we rarely know how to open them and use them effectively.

All the participating students were very enthusiastic and 100% participated in all the training activities. We are thankful to the trainers for providing excellent

A total of 25 students took admission in this course. This course was offered only for the Sem –IV students. The course lectures commenced from the day of inauguration where by Dr. Anita Jawanjal (DDMO) gave a brief outlook about Disaster Management along with the ways of prevention and Mitigation. Further course lectures were conducted by Dr. Shrividhya Jayakumar, Prof. Dr. Mahesh Barve and Asst. Prof. Krishna Kamath. A special Practical Training in disaster management was held on 27th May 2023 by, Mr. Vivek Naidu and Mr. Lakan Gaikwad who are the Master Trainers from Yashwantrao Chavan Academy of Development Administration (YASHADA) Pune. Many intriguing components were incorporated to the training such as learning various types of life-saving knots, basic first aid, life support (CPR), and fire extinguishment, among others. Exams were conducted on 30th June 2023. All the 25 students appeared for the examination. On 4th July 2023 a Viva was also conducted for the students. The results for both written exam and viva were declared on 11th July 2023. All the 25 students passed the Certificate programme successfully. 7 students secured O Grade, 9 secured A+ Grade, 7 secured A Grade and the 2 students secured B Grade. We are sure that the students were enlightened and now they are better equipped to prevent and mitigate any natural or manmade disaster.

Sleep- a facet of right to life...

Let me sleep....it is my right

(World sleep day: 17 March)

Lullaby is the voice of God for blessing a baby with sleep. Sleep is associated inappropriately with laziness not with standing the fact that sleep is essential. Certainly, irresponsible sleep and overindulgence are not correct and are undoubtedly condemnable. But good night sleep is inevitable for a good day work. Supreme Court of India has brought out the importance of sleep in its judgment in 2012 and has all the more elevated it to a component of right to life.

Supreme Court of India (SC) has emerged as a protector of health and human rights of the people of India. SC in its Criminal Original Jurisdiction entertained a Suo Motu Writ Petition (Crl.) No. 122 OF 2011 IN RE: RAMLILA MAIDAN INCIDENT DT.4/5.06.2011 v. HOME SECRETARY, UNION OF INDIA & ORS. The bench was constituted by Hon'ble Judges Swantanter KumarJ and Dr B S Chauhan J. The judgment is important as a ruling suo motto, a crucial interpretation of S. 144 of Cr P C and a leap forward in human rights jurisprudence in terms of recognition of a new right and in award of compensation.

Dr. Rajeev Dhavan was commissioned by the court as learned amicus curiae. The main judgment in 238 paragraphs was penned by J Swanter Kumar. J Chauhan has also recorded his views in 39 paragraphs.

In this case, the SC thought it appropriate to invoke suo motto its jurisdiction to review the legal and constitutional propriety of the government order u S. 144 of Cr P C to impose prohibition against the people sleeping after yoga sessions in Delhi. Just after midnight, at about 12.30 a.m. on the 5th of June, 2011, a

huge contingent of about more than a thousand policemen surrounded the encampments while everybody was fast asleep inside. There was a sizeable crowd of about 20,000 persons who were sleeping. They were forcibly woken up by the Police, assaulted physically and were virtually thrown out of their tents. This was done in the purported exercise of the police powers conferred under Section 144 Cr. P.C. on the strength of a prohibitory order dated 4.6.2011 passed by the Assistant Commissioner of Police. The court ruled that the exercise was unwarranted and illegal and awarded a compensation of Rs 5 lakh for persons who got killed, Rs 50,000/ for those grievously injured and Rs 25,000/ to those injured in a lighter manner. SC directed that the police who were guilty of inaction and excesses should be identified and disciplinary action be initiated within 3 months.

The judgment marks the recognition of right to sleep as a concomitant of right to life guaranteed as a fundamental right in Article 21 of the Constitution of India. Excerpts from the judgment:

12. Deprivation of sleep has tumultuous adverse effects. It causes a stir and disturbs the quiet and peace of an individual's physical state. A natural process which is inherent in a human being if disturbed obviously affects basic life. It is for this reason that if a person is deprived of sleep, the effect thereof, is treated to be torturous. To take away the right of natural rest is also therefore violation of a human right. It becomes a violation of a fundamental right when it is disturbed intentionally, unlawfully and for no justification. To arouse a person suddenly, brings about a feeling of shock and be numbness. The pressure of a sudden awakening results in almost a void of sensation. Such an action, therefore, does affect the basic life of an individual. The state of sleeping is assumed by an individual when he is in a safe atmosphere. It is for this reason that this natural system has been inbuilt by our creator to provide relaxation to a human

being. The muscles are relaxed and this cycle has a normal recurrence every night and lasts for several hours. This necessity is so essential that even all our transport systems provide for facilities of sleep while travelling. Sleep is therefore, both, life and inherent liberty which cannot be taken away by any unscrupulous action. An Irish Proverb goes on to say that the beginning of health is sleep....

....An individual is entitled to sleep as comfortably and as freely as he breathes. Sleep is essential for a human being to maintain the delicate balance of health necessary for its very existence and survival. Sleep is, therefore, a fundamental and basic requirement without which the existence of life itself would be in peril. To disturb sleep, therefore, would amount to torture which is now accepted as a violation of human right. It would be similar to a third degree method which at times is sought to be justified as a necessary police action to extract the truth out of an accused involved in heinous and coldblooded crimes. It is also a device adopted during warfare where prisoners of war and those involved in espionage are subjected to treatments depriving them of normal sleep. (para 38)
